BAGO Forest Classic

23rd October 2010.

In 2010, the 30th anniversary of the last Southern Cross, the Hastings Sporting Car Club has planned an event to cater for all rally enthusiasts.

The event will be known as the “Bago Forest Classic”. It has been planned to be a competitive rally with the inclusion of Classic Rally cars, Club Rally Cars and Production Rally Cars (PRC). The event will also be a round of the Clubman rally series, Hyundai Excel Race Brakes Rally series and the NNSW rally series.

The Bago Forest Classic will consist of up to 200klms Competitive with 180klms of transport. The stages have been selected to get to most out of the area, giving the best value to the competitor. There will be 10-12 stages varied in length from 4.6klm to 45.3klms. The competitive stages will be run on one day only.

The “Series” Contenders- Clubman, Excel and NNSW will have a point where that series’ points will be scored from. For example service after 120klms or so, then, they will be able to finish the event if they wish with no further loss or gain to there series result.

We are planning to run a Classic field separate to PRC. As long as we get the support in numbers of Classics, we will be running two fields.

Like Previous years, the event will be based around the small township of Kendall, aprx 20min South of Port Macquarie & 40 min North of Taree. The service park, Doco, Scrutineering, Start & Finish will all be in the one location, Kendall showgrounds. Camping will also be available at the showgrounds so to allow ALL competitors to more social both Pre & Post event.

Although event plans are well underway, some details are not yet finalized. Further information will be made available when confirmed.
